

Quality Updates

A single cumulative update each month with no new features

- Security fixes, reliability fixes, bug fixes, etc.
- Supersedes the previous month's update



Feature Updates

“One” in the second half of the year with new features

- New features and innovation APIs and security capabilities
- Very reliable, with built-in rollback capabilities
- Simple deployment using in-place upgrade, driven by existing tools
